5 Field Inspection Events

To become an Illinois-licensed home inspector, you must:

- 1. successfully complete an approved pre-licensing course, including five field inspection events (see below);
- 2. pass the Illinois Home Inspector License Exam; and
- 3. submit the application and fee to the state.

License applicants must have their supervising home inspector submit to InterNACHI a list of the five (5) field inspection events that were performed. Send this scanned document to the education department at education@internachi.org at Do not mail this information.

"Fleld Inspection Event" means an examination and evaluation of the exterior and interior components of an actual residential real property conducted by a candidate for a home inspection license under the supervision of a licensed home inspector with at least 5 years of experience.
